Does not speak English. Claims to speak Russian fairly fluently, learned during HIS nine years of confinement in various Soviet POW camps. Fluency could not not be tested or confirmed.

Unknown. However, claimed that HE is currently not authorized to travel to Soviet Bloc areas. The same applied during the period HE was employed at the Federal Ministry of the Interior nor was HE then authorized to travel to Western countries without special prior approval.

Served with the German Army (Wehrmacht) during WW II, unit(s), position and rank unknown. Claimed to have been held in various Soviet POW camps from 1945 to 1956, which included working in a coal mine. Spent an unknown period of time in an area near Moscow.

Claimed to have joined the Bundesgrenzschutz (BGS) during 1957, served about three years with the Signal Battalion, DUISDORF (LB 6220), as Deputy Battalion Commander. Later served in the BGS Security Department, Federal Ministry of the Interior, Branch VI, until HE was reassigned to the present position.

Speaks fluent English. Comes from the area of the State of Schleswig-Holstein, FRG, and she still speaks the dialect of that area and has difficulties in understanding the Bavarian dialect. Is SUBJECT's second wife and the marriage took place about during 1967. SUBJECT's first wife died of a heart disease during 1967.

a. Daughter: Sabine or Sabina, estimated age 14 years, born during the first marriage. Currently resides with the parents and attends a German school in Munich. Sabine(a) already speaks some school English and is otherwise a smart and good looking girl.

SUBJECT's religion is unknown but whatever HIS religion may be, it will most likely not influence HIS official actions because HE appears to be objective and liberal in HIS way of thinking.

53. ACQUAINTANCES AND RELATIVES - Apparent influence of acquaintances and relatives on subject's views or career.

SUBJECT has a twin brother who currently resides somewhere in the Rheinland, FRG. His occupation is unknown. The extent SUBJECT is or could be influenced by acquaintances or relatives is unknown.

54. CHARACTER - Subject's character, strengths and weaknesses, intelligence, loyalty, judgment, ability to communicate, leadership ability, and influence. Significance of individual in shaping international policies of his country.

SUBJECT appears to be of character, is intelligent, appears to exercise good judgment, has an excellent ability of communicating with others, and has the ability of organizing.

55. POLITICAL ORIENTATION - Attitude towards United States and other countries. Remarks and actions of subject toward representatives of the United States and its allies, and to representatives of nonaligned nations and Communist bloc nationals. Political activities and attitudes, important political contacts, party affiliations, potential political influence in country in the event of a change in government.

SUBJECT is very friendly and appears to have a very positive attitude towards the United States intelligence effort in the FRG. SUBJECT has been heard criticizing leading German governmental officials and politicians of being too soft in dealings with Communist countries or domestic activities which are Communist influenced.

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56. PERSONAL APPEARANCE - Appraisal of subject's dress, personal habits, mannerisms, eccentricities, peculiarities of speech and gait, prominent or unusual physical features, e.g., teeth, eyes, shape of face, complexion, tendency toward balding, etc.

SUBJECT is usually well, but conservatively, dressed when he wears civilian clothing. HE does not appear to have any eccentricities or peculiarities.

57. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON SPOUSE - Spouse's political views, appearance, personality, attitude toward United States and other countries, influence on husband. Spouse's family connections influencing the husband's career.

SUBJECT's spouse has a very pleasant personality. SUBJECT once indicated that HIS spouse once worked for BND, capacity and location not specified, before HE married her.

58. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

- a. Length of time collector has known subject and frequency of contact(s). Indicate how much of the information is based on the collector's own observation. Indicate other sources for information on subject.

SUBJECT has been contacted occasionally, an average of once a month, since HIS assignment to the present position. All information is based on the Collector's own observation.

- b. Best ways of gaining subject's confidence and exerting influence on him.

Approach and deal with SUBJECT in a business-like manner. Observe and make appropriate gestures during SUBJECT's own personal anniversaries or those of his family.

- c. Military reputation, competence, and significance. Include financial status, dependence on personal or political connections for military position. Reputation in own service, collector's own assessment of military competence, and military and/or political potential of subject.

SUBJECT appears to be very competent in security operations and HE appears to be fairly well liked by HIS subordinates. Militarily HE also appears to be competent and it is very likely that HE may be promoted to LTC within the near future. SUBJECT was assigned to the Federal Ministry of the Interior (BGS) during the time the current Commanding General of Grenzschutzkommando Sued was assigned there and they often appear to share the same views on operational matters. It has been heard from a number of BGS Staff sources that the current CG has requested SUBJECT by name for the current position. SUBJECT appears to have and cultivated working relations to sources at BND Headquarters, closer than his predecessors. The cooperation between those agencies also appears to have improved accordingly. One of the BND officials SUBJECT knows fairly well or has considerable dealings with is a man called "MERTENS", (Phonetic and most likely a cover name.)

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
