1. XBOLSCHWING (all data submitted on prior occasion).
2. (Dr.) Anton BOEHM (all data submitted on prior occasion).
3. Inge von der TANN, Secretary (data submitted on prior occasion).
4. (Dr.) Walter HAUSHERR, 34 years old; doctor of law; tax advisor; divorced; living in Gmunden.
5. (Dr.) Hermann PFAUNDLER-HADERMAUR, 67 years old; section chief of the Bundeskanzleramt. Holds direct connection with Chancellor FIGL and Vice-Chancellor Dr. SCHAEFER. Lives in Vienna.
6. (Dr.) Josef WIRTHE, 65 years old; section chief of President Dr. RENNER. Holds direct connection with President RENNER.
7. Wolfgang PFAUNDLER, 27 years old; student of philosophy; leads an Association of former Resistance; has connections with now leading personalities of resistance background.
8. (Dr.) Wolfram BITSCHNAU, 28 years old; advocate's assistant; married; two children; living in Innsbruck. BITSCHNAU during his highschool years was imprisoned by Nazis for legitimist relations. After having been drafted into the German Army and having been wounded, he was first used as a decipherer and later as archivar within the German OKW up to 1945. After the German surrender he first worked with French intelligence--a connection that has since ceased to exist.
9. Wilhelm DIETRICH, gendarmery inspector in charge of investigation branch of Landesgendarmarie-Kommando Vorarlberg. Employs continuously a number of subsources named in Reports A to Z.
10. Hans Joerg KIRSCH, 26 years old, son of the Austrian General KIRSCH (chief of legitimists in Tyrol), student of law.
11. (Dr.) VEITER, prior to 1938, a government official with the Bundeskanzleramt.
12. (Dr.) Leopold VOLLER
13. (Dr.) Karl v. WINKLER
14. (Dr.) Anton FELLNER, 41 years old, living in Altmuenster; officially employed by the establishment Franz MITTERBAUER, Laakirchen; married; two children. FELLNER was educated as a lawyer; during Nazi times he was an Oberregierungsrat with the Upper Austrian government. At the :

was chief of press and cultural affairs. Since 1943 he has opposed the Nazis and taken up connection with a Socialist opposition group led by, now mayor of Linz, (Dr) Ernst KOREF.

15. Bundesrat Karl KRAMER, land party secretary Socialist Party Upper Austria. Collaborates on a voluntary basis and informs on internal party matters.
16. (Dr.) Philipp METZLER, 41 years old, former Oberlandesgerichtsrat, now teacher of law with a private law school in Vienna. On payroll; specializing on Communist and pink connections through intellectual friends.
17. Hans AMBROSIC, 65 years old, former member of the imperial Austrian Parliament, now assistant editor of the Graz socialist paper "Neue Zeit"; on payroll; on friendly basis.
18. (Dr.) Fritz von TONGEL, 43 years old, former pharmacist; during Nazi times leading member of the propaganda office in Vienna, now commercial traveler. Collaborates on a friendly basis.
19. Herbert KALHOFER, 39 years old, living at Velden/Noerthersee, former SS-officer, now commercial employee, specializes on VdU- and OeVP-connections in Carinthia. On part payroll.
20. Guenther PROKSCH, 31 years old, living at Vienna as commercial employee. Son of Alfred PROKSCH, a former illegal Nazi party chief of Austria, who opposed the Anschluss. Specializes on Nazi pink connections, on payroll.
21. (Dr.) Walter SCHNEEFUSS, 50 years old, employee of the Chamber of Commerce in Graz, influential with OeVP; collaborates on part payroll.
22. (Dr.) Walter HARNER, 41 years old, member of the OeVP-Landesleitung Styria and employee of the Chamber of Commerce, during the war chief of propaganda office Triest, collaborates on part payroll.
23. Anton KRONBERGER, 62 years old, former gendarmery officer. Holds connections with Austrian security offices in Styria. Collaborates on part payroll.
24. (Dr.) BRUNNER, 44 years old, former professor with Graz University; now director of the editors STOCKER at Graz.
