Developmental Project Outline

Landseer 10

1. Basic Objectives:

Long and short range penetration of the Austrian Police service

2. Specific Objectives:

- a. Penetration of the Vorarlberg Security Directorate
- b. Procurement of information on persons of GE interest in Vorarlberg and Tirol and persons travelling to and from Switzerland
- c. Penetration of the KPOs on the Vorarlberg province level
- d. Procurement of information on the FIS in Vorarlberg
- e. Information on the activities of Zipper, Usage and other intelligence groups

3. Cover personnel:

Landseer 10

4. Contact and Control:

Contact: Prearranged meetings once a month at various places in Tirol

Control: After the severance of the Landseer 10-Mandl-Zipper connection, it will be possible to control Landseer 10 on the basis of payments on which he will be dependents, signed receipts, copies of Austrian police documents which could be used to discredit him with the Austrian authorities.

5. Proposed Cover:

- a. Agent: Landseer 10(s duties as officer assigned to the Vorarlberg Gendarmerie investigation unit.
- b. Case Officer: [] is known to Landseer 10 as [] an American Government employee of Austrian birth.
- c. Organization. [] introduced himself to Landseer 10 as an employee of G-2 USFA. Landseer 10 who has heard of G-2 has not asked any further questions.

6. Estimated costs:

- a. Contract status: not applicable
- b. Supplies per month: none
- c. Money salary per month: 2000 schillings

d. Travel and other expenses: Not to exceed 500 schillings per month

f. If dropped or compromised: One month's salary

If captured or killed: 3-6 month's salary to Landseer 10's mother who is dependent on Landseer 10.

The success of the project hinges on the question of exclusive control which can only be achieved if Landseer 10's connection with Zipper is terminated. We have been assured by that this is the case. Confirmation from Headquarters would be appreciated.
