SUBJECT: **PERIPHERALS** Submission of Bulgarian Emigre Publication "Borba"

In the event the Department may not be in possession of number 11-12 (August-September issue) of the Bulgarian emigre publication "Borba" ("Struggle"), there is attached for the files a single copy obtained by the Peripheral Reporting Unit of this Consulate General.

For the first time, several copies of this periodical which is published (mimeographed) in the Bulgarian language by Ivan Dochev and the Bulgarian National Front in Canada (11 Thorncliffe Ave., Toronto 6, Ontario, Canada) have recently been received in Istanbul for distribution among the Bulgarian refugees. With the exception of a few items of a general character, most of this issue is devoted to articles and editorials on the former Bulgarian King - Boris III.

Also enclosed is a pamphlet in the English language, entitled "King Boris of Bulgaria and His Policy". This pamphlet which was printed by the Bulgarian Royalists (Bulgarian National Front) in Germany, evidently for distribution among foreigners, has also been obtained recently from local Bulgarian refugees in Istanbul.
