

SE Agreement on Points to Settle with Dochev on 3 Jan 57

1. Congress of Bulgarian National Front
How did the Congress go off? Were there any material changes in by-laws or organization? Can we still consider Dochev as sole spokesman?
(If possible, Woodruff or Allen will sound Baharoff out on these questions before we meet Dochev)
2. Did Dochev broach the subject of his European trip during the Congress? Did he get a fund drive started to finance the trip? If so, are there likely to be contributions enough to furnish some cover?
3. At this meeting we will formally present Dochev the names of the stateside Bug W/T operators we have contacted (though we believe he already knows of these contacts) and ask if he will give them the go-ahead to work freely with us.
4. Proposed Trip Abroad - Our Position
We expect the trip should take not over 90 and probably not much less than 60 days. We will subsidize his loss of income from his trucking business at the rate of \$500. a month while he is away, exclusive of travel and per diem as previously stated. However, we do not wish him to abandon his trucking business on the expectation that we will employ or subsidize him in Canada or elsewhere after his return. If his absence does put his business on the rocks we will at that time talk about how we can help him get back on his feet, but we don't want to go into any advance arrangement of long-term subsidy, partial or otherwise. (This amounts to an SE decision here and now that if we reach an impasse on this point, all bets are off for the use of Dochev or his organization for the time being)
