| <p>1. The letters and published material received from <u>GOMACE</u> since his termination have all been unsolicited, voluntary contributions. Judging from the text of his last letter forwarded with reference the flow will now dry up and we can see no reason to prime the pump again.</p> <p>2. [ ] keeps us abreast of the developments in the "Temporary Representation Abroad" but we have no accurate picture of the status of the national front group headed by Paul K. SUROCI and several of our PBPRIME ZRNAUNTLE friends. Any readily available material on this group would be appreciated. The impact (if any) of the formation of the Bulgarian National Council has not been felt yet in Europe. [ ] has reported on a plan to organize a Bulgarian cultural center called "<u>Bulgarian Community</u>" composed of "people outside Madrid and the G. M. DIMITROV committee". Names figuring these plans are Dr. N. P. NIKOLAYEV in Sweden, Sava KIROV, Dimitur SHISHMANOV, Dimitur PANITSA in Paris and other middle of the road to monarchist emigres in various parts of the world. The group, if it is organized, intends to collect and republish documents, memoirs and historical and cultural books in Bulgarian and other languages. A photostat of a letter concerning this organization and containing its projected statutes is attached.</p> <p>3. For one whole year I have kept you abreast of our affairs in order to give you the possibility to see that what I have told you is the truth, specifically that Stetov and his several boys around do not regret and will not be able to regret the Bulgarian National Front.

It must be regretted that trust was given to them and that you decided to work with them and invest sums in their work, which sums, naturally, went down the drain. Attached I am sending you the magazine "Borba" from which you will learn of our glorious success at the Congress and the excellent talks, as well as the establishment of the Bulgarian National Council. Truly, the founding of this council about the Bulgarian representation abroad (temporarily representation) to the very foundation and that it is now hanging completely in air. However, given the situation existing, it was to be expected that all this happened in this way as a natural result (of our position). I am also enclosing a copy of the invitation to the meeting of the National Council, from which you will see the beginning of an activity which will assuredly give results and which will advantage the BNA. Nothing more could have been expected as long as Stetov and company were given the task of doing the job. They were never capable nor had the authority to do anything.

More than a year has elapsed since you have written to me and I, therefore, consider that I have fulfilled my friendly obligation towards you to the end and that from henceforth, if we are to resume contact, it will be if you take the initiative.
