1. Following the several conversations between Mr. [redacted] and Mr. [redacted], I have checked all area components of CS on their interest in names and addresses of persons who wrote to President Eisenhower in behalf of subjects prior to their execution. Interest in, and anticipated value of, such information is substantial with respect to the areas listed below.

2. It is understood that you are in a position to review referenced correspondence. It is also understood that review of some 69,000 pieces will be a time consuming undertaking. Therefore if you find that personnel not assigned to your office can have access to these files, please let us know if the loan of CS personnel would expedite and simplify your task.

3. It is requested that names and addresses of correspondents favoring the ROSENBERGS be extracted from reference correspondence wherever such names and addresses are included in the original correspondence, in the case of messages originating in the following foreign areas:

Sweden

Denmark

Asia Minor with the exception of Iran

All Asiatic countries

Indonesia and the Philippines

All African countries

All Latin American countries
