1. AS OF 29 NOVEMBER 1980, SENIOR SALVADORAN  
MILITARY OFFICERS PLANNED NO ADDITIONAL SECURITY MEASURES  
IN REACTION TO THE 27 NOVEMBER 1980 DEATH OF SIX  
REVOLUTIONARY DEMOCRATIC FRONT (FD) LEADERS IN THE  
CAPITAL CITY OF SAN SALVADOR AS MOST MILITARY OFFICERS  
BELIEVE THE LEFT IS NOW TOO WEAK AND DEORGANIZED TO  
BE EFFECTIVE. NORMAL MILITARY PATROL ACTIVITIES IN  
SAN SALVADOR HAVE BEEN MAINTAINED AND THERE ARE NO

PLANS TO INCREASE THE PATROLS AT THE [REDACTED] TIME. SOME TROOPS HAVE BEEN CONFINED TO THE [REDACTED] BLOCKS AREAS UNTIL THE SITUATION IN THE CITY [REDACTED] OR SHOULD AN EMERGENCY ARISE. NO TROOPS WILL [REDACTED] INTO SAN SALVADOR FROM THE INTERIOR AS THE [REDACTED] OF THE HARVEST IS OF HIGH PRIORITY AND TROOP [REDACTED] BE SPARED FOR SAN SALVADOR. LEFTIST PLANS FOR [REDACTED] AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT ARE NOT KNOWN BUT ARE [REDACTED] TO BE EXTENSIVE. THE TIMING FOR THE [REDACTED] THE SLAIN FDR LEADERS IS ALSO NOT KNOWN AND NO [REDACTED] MILITARY PLANS HAVE BEEN MADE IN REGARD TO HOW [REDACTED] GENERAL WILL BE HANDLED.
