1. [REDACTED] HAS PROVIDED FOLLOWING TRACES ON JACOBUS ANDRIES ((KOSTER)), BORN 9 JANUARY 1936 IN SINT-ANNA PAROCHIE, NETHERLANDS, LAST WEST BERLIN RESIDENCE LIMONEN-STRASSE 26, BERLIN 45. ARRIVED BERLIN ON 30 OCTOBER 1963 FROM BEVENSINGEL 76, KAMPEN KR. OVERIJSEL, NETHERLANDS. KOSTER WAS HEAD OF YOUTH CIRCLE OF THE DUTCH CHURCH COMMUNITY IN WEST BERLIN AND MEMBER OF THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION OF THE WEST BERLIN REGIONAL COMMITTEE OF THE CHRISTIAN PEACE CONFERENCE. ON 29 AUGUST 1966 KOSTER ISSUED A CIRCULAR TO MEMBERS OF THE WEST BERLIN DUTCH COMMUNITY YOUTH CIRCLE, INVITING THEM TO AN EXCHANGE VISIT WITH A CHURCH YOUTH COMMUNITY IN LEIPZIG ON 10-11 SEPTEMBER 1966.

2. [REDACTED] KOSTER, A DUTCH JOURNALIST RECENTLY KILLED IN EL SALVADOR, HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A REGULAR FREE LANCE CORRESPONDENT FOR THE EAST GERMAN CDU JOURNAL, "NEUE ZEIT."
