... OF SAN PEDRO SULA PUBLISHED ON 29 MARCH SCRIPT OF RECENT TV INTERVIEW WITH SUBJECT. IN IT, SUBJECT DISCUSSED HIS ALLEGED MILITANCE IN PEOPLES LIBERATION FORCES (FPL), INCLUDING HIS ALLEGED PARTICIPATION IN THE MARCH 1980 ASSASSINATION OF ARCHBISHOP OSCAR ARNULFO ROMERO. ON THIS TOPIC, SUBJECT CHARGED THAT ASSASSINATION WAS ARRANGED BY THE FPL LEADERSHIP COUNCIL MADE UP AT THAT TIME BY SALVADOR CAYETANO CARPIO, NELIDA ANAYA MONTES, MARIO CARRANZA AND A SPANISH CATHOLIC NUN NAMED DOMINICA WHO ACCORDING TO SUBJECT, CURRENTLY IS IN HONDURAS WORKING AT A SALVADORAN REFUGEE CAMP AND IS CARRANZA'S MISTRESS. SUBJECT SAID DECISION TO KILL ROMERO WAS MADE OUT OF NEED TO CREATE A "MARTYR." HIT TEAM CONSISTED OF TEN PERSONS INCLUDING SUBJECT, WHO PLAYED SUPPORT ROLE. TRAINING TOOK PLACE IN MANAGUA AND GRENADA. ACTUAL TRIGGERMAN WAS MIGUEL ANGEL ((BLANDINO)) NERIO, BROTHER OF ROGER BLANDINO. SUBJECT ALSO CLAIMED HE WAS DIRECT CONTACT BETWEEN FPL AND HONDURAN ARMY COLONEL LEONIDAS ((TORRES)) ARIAS, WHO ALLOWED ARMS TRAFFIC TO FPL GUERRILLAS IN EXCHANGE FOR MONEY. SUBJECT SAID HIS LAST PAYMENT TO TORRES (IN CA 1978) WAS 1.7 MILLION DOLLARS CASH.
