1. AT 1100 HOURS 8 JULY CHINESE COMMUNIST CIVILANS WEARING RED ARMBANDS BETWEEN 100 AND 300 INDIVIDUALS, INFLTRATED HONG KONG TERRITORY AT SHATAUKOK IN THE NEW TERRITORIES AREA OF HONG KONG. THESE INFILTRATORS ATTEMPTED TO LAY A DYNAMITE CHARGE TO BLOW UP A POLICE POST IN SHATAUKOK BUT WERE APPPEHNDED BY HONG KONG POLICE WHO ATTEMPTED TO ARREST THE INFILTRATORS. A FIRE FIGHT BEGAN. THREE OF THE HONG KONG POLICEMEN WERE SHOT AND KILLED, TWO OF THE CHINESE INFILTRATORS WERE KILLED. SHORTLY AFTER 1200 HOURS ELEMENTS OF THE BRITISH MILITARY WERE ORDERED INTO THE SHATAUKOK AREA IN A SWEEP TO DISLODGE THE INFILTRATORS AND

FORCE THEM BACK ACROSS THE BORDER. THIS ACTION WAS STILL CONTINUING AS OF 1430 HOURS LOCAL.

2. BOTH HONG KONG ISLAND AND KOWLOON AREA OF HONG KONG COLLECTIVELY REMAINED QUIET THROUGHOUT THE MORNING AND EARLY AFTERNOON.
