MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Progress Report on the Implementation of Recommendation No. 3 of the Report to the President by the President's Board of Consultants on Foreign Intelligence Activities

1. The President, after consideration of the agency comments thereon, has directed action as indicated below on the following recommendation of the President's Board of Consultants on Foreign Intelligence Activities:

Recommendation: "We urge that action be expedited to bring the planning for intelligence activities in time of war to the highest feasible state of readiness and that a realistic war gaming of them begin as soon as practicable."

Action: "Approve, and refer to the Director of Central Intelligence and the Joint Chiefs of Staff for the necessary coordination of action by member agencies of the Intelligence Advisory Committee."

In approving the above action the President has directed that a progress report be submitted to him as soon as practicable and prior to taking final action.

2. The above matter has been the subject of discussions between the Central Intelligence Agency and the Joint Chiefs of Staff and a letter reporting thereon to the President, signed jointly by the Director of Central Intelligence and the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, has been forwarded to the President under separate cover. A copy of this letter is attached.
