1. WE HAVE RECEIVED AND REVIEWED THE DIA DRAFT "STANDARD
OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR DIA TASKING OF CIA COLLECTION RELATIVE
TO POW/MIA AFFAIRS" AND OUR SUGGESTED CHANGES TO THE DRAFT ARE
GIVEN BELOW. WE ARE TRYING TO INCREASE EFFORTS ON POW/MIA
REPORTING IN OUR EAST ASIAN STATIONS AND THIS NEW "SOP" SHOULD
HELP US STREAMLINE PROCEDURES FOR PASSING REQUIREMENTS TO THE
FIELD AND PROVIDING MORE TIMELY REPORTING. THE FOCUS OF OUR
EFFORTS CONTINUES TO BE ON RECENTLY ARRIVED REFUGEE SOURCES IN
MALAYSIA, THAILAND, AND HONG KONG. WE BELIEVE THIS EFFORT TO
STREAMLINE THE FLOW OF REPORTING AND REQUIREMENTS WILL MAKE OUR
SYSTEM MORE EFFECTIVE AND MORE PRODUCTIVE. WE HOPE YOU WILL
AGREE WITH THE MODIFICATIONS WE HAVE MADE TO THIS "SOP" AND
THAT WE CAN GET THIS NEW AND IMPROVED SYSTEM WORKING.

2. (S// [REDACTED]) THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES WILL PREVAIL.
A. DIA'S COLLECTION REQUIREMENTS WILL BE TRANSMITTED BY
SDR ADDRESSED FOR ACTION TO CIA WASHINGTON DC//DO [REDACTED] WITH
INFORMATION ADDRESSEE USDAO (RELEVANT LOCATION). THESE
REQUIREMENTS WILL BE PREPARED IN STERILE TEAR-LINE FORMAT TO
STREAMLINE HANDLING IN THE FIELD.

B. THE MESSAGE WILL CONTAIN INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USDAO TO
PASS THE MESSAGE TO THE LOCAL [REDACTED] (S// [REDACTED]).

C. THE MESSAGE WILL ALSO CONTAIN INSTRUCTIONS THAT THE
LOCAL [REDACTED] (S// [REDACTED]) AND THE USDAO DETERMINE WHICH UNIT IS IN THE
BEST POSITION TO COLLECT INFORMATION ON THE REQUIREMENTS. THE
COLLECTING UNIT WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PREPARING AND
TRANSMITTING A REPORT CONTAINING INFORMATION COLLECTED IN
RESPONSE TO THE TASKING.

COLLECTION MANAGEMENT AGREEMENTS BETWEEN DIA AND CIA WITHIN THE
NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE COLLECTION SYSTEM.
