

Pro-Communist Student Group in Colombia Plans Demonstrations Against OAS Meeting in Bogota: According to a fairly reliable source, the Communist-dominated Colombian Students' Union (UNEC) is preparing daily demonstrations against the OAS meeting of the Committee of 21 scheduled to begin in Bogota on 5 September to formulate plans for economic development in the hemisphere. The UNEC executive committee proposed the demonstrations as a substitute for pro-Castro gatherings in Colombia against the American foreign ministers' meeting in San Jose, which Rolando Cubelas, top pro-Communist Cuban youth leader, had requested via letter to the UNEC. The Colombian Communist party will probably cooperate with the UNEC in organizing any pro-Cuban, anti-OAS activities.

Cubela's appeal is further evidence of Cuban intervention in Colombia's domestic affairs--an issue which recently was

introduced for debate in the Colombian Congress and provoked a denial by the Cuban ambassador in Bogota.

Protest activity against the Committee of 21 meeting, which will probably be boycotted by the Dominican Republic and possibly by Cuba, would be consistent with Latin American Communist and Cuban efforts to undermine the OAS and inter-American solidarity.
