1. The total strength of the Russian army in Manchuria is around 250,000 troops, concentrated mostly in and near Mukden, Changchun, Kirin, Mutanchiang (129-37, 44-35), Harbin and Bairen. Approximately 50,000 of these are mechanized troops.
2. The following is an incomplete list of Russian mechanized forces with locations:

3. On 19 February a Russian mechanized unit with 400 medium tanks moved into Paichengtzu (122-52, 45-37). Of those tanks, 30 moved on 21 February to Nanling in the city of Changchun.
4. On 22 February approximately 50,000 Russian troops moved into the area of Chalantun (122-45, 43-01), west of the Nun River.
