1. The following Japanese arms were transferred to the Chinese Communists by the Russians in the Antung (124-23, 40-09) area:
 - a. 13,000 rifles, Model 38, formerly held by Japanese Unit with code number 1038 of the Southern Garrison Headquarters.
[SSU Washington Note: 1038 was previously reported as the code number for the 42 Independent Mountain Battalion.]
 - b. 6,000 rifles, Model 99, formerly held by the Japanese YASUDA [?] and WIZUDA [?] units.
 - c. 2,400 rifles Models 38 and 99, formerly held by the Manchoukou garrison troops stationed at Fengcheng (124-03, 40-23), Kaochiatze [?] and Kaolicheng [?]
 - d. 300 light machine guns formerly held by the Japanese garrison troops in the Antung area.
 - e. 1,200 rifles of different models which formerly belonged to Japanese reserves in various towns.
 - f. Miscellaneous:

1. Light machine guns	470
2. Heavy machine guns	80
3. Grenade throwers	380
4. Mountain guns	12
5. Field guns	6
6. Hand grenades	70,000
