C-0 1. The 2 Division of the Chinese Communist New 4 Army was trained by the Russians at Faku (123-23, 42-31).

C-4 2. On 28 January (sic) at the Antung Chamber of Commerce, the Russians issued the following weapons to the Chinese Communists:

- 17,500 type 38 rifles
- 7,800 type 79 [? 99 ?] rifles
- 1400 rifles of other types
- 1400 pistols of various kinds
- 470 light machine guns
- 8 heavy machine guns
- 30 trench mortars
- 230 bomb throwing instruments
- 12 cannon
- 6 field artillery pieces
- 700 hand grenades
- 700,000 rounds of various types of ammunition
- 3,000 bombs of various types

The above equipment had been surrendered by the Japanese 3038 [? 1038?] Regiment and other units in South Manchuria.
