1. On 10 April 1946, the Russian Army between Hailar (119-44, 49-19) and Tsitsihar (Lungchiang, 123-57, 47-22) engaged an unknown detachment of Chinese. The Russians suffered one hundred casualties. The Chinese had three hundred casualties.
2. The Russian authorities claim the attack was provoked by Kuomintang agents. Several other engagements are reported to have taken place in other districts of Manchuria.
