SUBJECT: DANANG Station Monthly Report for March, 1969

ABM/SGN arrived in DaNang on 29 March after one week TCS at Nha-Trang as Acting Station Manager there. At the moment he is finding the DaNang area a much more complex environment (over-all) to because adjusted to VS Nha-Trang because of geographic considerations and the immense scope of military operations in the area. Otherwise the level of AAM operations appears to be quite similar.

It is obvious my predecessor has done much in a short period of time to improve our facilities. Three major projects remain to be done: Paving of the open ramp area around the nose hangar and completion of the hangar lean-to to provide an efficient working environment for the Chief Mechanic, his staff and also automotive maintenance. These functions have been "camping out" for too long. Also the completion of our remote VHF/UHF facilities [REDACTED] needs stimulated action. In coordination with COMENG SGN, this will be done.

Less strategic to our local situation is our Snack-Bar operated by the Air Force NCO Club - it needs a good cleaning up plus more space to configure it into a more efficient and pleasant facility.

With the completion of the hangar lean-to, cited above, and the movement of the Chief Mechanic's office from the Administrative Operations Building, we will be in position to correct this problem.

Meanwhile the squeeze is on the Air Force management to improve their standards.
