



The statistics indicate that the regime has more individuals in custody now than it did 12 days ago. Government officials have been noticeably reticent about when these people will be released, but it is clear that the regime fears many would quickly become involved in political activity on Solidarity's behalf. This perception suggests that many of the detained will not be released for several months at the least. This issue will continue to generate tensions between the Church, the Vatican, and Western governments on the one hand, and the Polish regime on the other. [REDACTED]
