[(b) (3)] (fnu) Rodzevitch,* representative of the White Russian emigrant organization called the Solidarists,** is attempting to encourage members of the White Russian colony to go clandestinely to the USSR as intelligence agents and promoters of sabotage and acts of terrorism. Rodzevitch arrived in Chile as an IRO immigrant in June 1948 and is now employed as a draftsman by the Instituto Geografica Militar. He lives at Calle Castro 354, Santiago. He is connected with the recently formed Solidarist branch in Buenos Aires.

2. The leaders of the international Solidarist movement are reported to be Victor Baydalakoff*** and Constantino Boldyreff, now residing in the United States. [(b) (3)] When the Germans occupied Yugoslavia in 1941, Baydalakoff went to Berlin and collaborated with the Reich Ministry for the Occupied Eastern Regions and the Todt Organization. He was instrumental in sending young White Russians into the USSR as translators with the German Army to be left behind in Russian territory as intelligence agents.

3. [(b) (3)] this White Russian group first sent supporters into the USSR between 1924 and 1927 to work against Communism. Allegedly, however, all of them were executed, since there was a Soviet spy in the organization who arranged for these dispatches to the USSR for the sole purpose of draining the strength of the White Russian groups.

4. [(b) (3)] Baydalakoff is "practically a Communist", and that the Solidarista are actually working for the Soviets in an attempt to destroy as many White Russian elements as possible.

*Washington Comment. Rodzevitch is believed to be possibly identical with one Aleksei Nikolayevich Rodzevich, about 35 years old, a long-time member of the Solidarists central group. He resided in Yugoslavia before World War II, and reportedly was once head of the Austrian Section of the organization.

**Washington Comment. The Solidarists group, also known as the Union of the New Generation (Soyuz Novogo Pokolenija), is believed to be identical with the Nacionalno Trudovoi Soyuz (NTS), which has been reported [(b) (3)] to be headed by Victor Baydalakoff in New York City.
