1. DANANG CITY REMAINS UNDER MARTIAL LAW AND STRICT CURFEW, WITH AMERICAN MILITARY ON FULL ALERT. THE VIET CONG (VC) MADE NO MAJOR EFFORT IN THE DANANG CITY AREA DURING THE NIGHT OF 2/3 FEBRUARY, ALTHOUGH AMERICAN MILITARY ADVISORS CONTINUED TO BE CONCERNED OVER REPORTS THAT A REGIMENT OF THE SECOND NORTH VIETNAMESE ARMY (NVA) WAS MOVING TOWARD DANANG (SEE FVG-245). THE VC INITIATED SMALL ARMS FIRE IN TWO AREAS ON THE EDGE OF DANANG AIR BASE AT ABOUT 0310 HOURS, FOLLOWED BY HEAVY AMERICAN ARTILLERY FIRE IN RETALIATION. ALL ACTION ENDED SOON AFTER 0400 HOURS.
