2. In both cases I have left item 26 blank since it is our recommendation that pay go on as usual for both these men. There would actually be no claim for compensation in addition to salaries since ten Hoop was treated in a Canadian Army Hospital and is completely recovered while [] was treated in a Dutch civilian hospital and has a personal insurance policy which covers hospital and doctors expenses. Actually ten Hoop is not paid by us, and the matter of his pay for the period of hospitalization is in other hands. In the case of [] however, it is our intention to pay him his salary as usual during the period of recuperation. We appreciate your assistance in this matter and would like to have your opinion on this proposal, as well as on any other aspects of the case which need further attention.
