Dear Ides,

Inclosed are the completed file cards on agents employed by Melanie, also a list giving an evaluation of each agent.

Regarding the Valkenburg Airport, it is now available for all types military aircraft except heavy bombers. It is not necessary to arrange clearance before taking off, but only to contact field from plane as you come in for landing. The only other factor to bear in mind is that the field has only one runway which runs North-South, while the prevailing wind is East-West, which means there is usually a crosswind on the runway.

Regarding the ferries, both the ferry at Hedel and the one at Moerdijk are open from 0800 to 2000 daily. For permission to cross the Hedel ferry apply to RTO office (adjacent to R.R. station) in 's-Hertogenbosch. For the Moerdijk ferry permission must be obtained in Breda at HQ, 5th L. of C. The ferry at Hedel is the less busy of the two and after crossing there is a good road into Gorinchem and from Gorinchem to Rotterdam.

Our peuching address is: United States Army, OSS Mission to the Netherlands, c/o Netherlands District, The Hague. Our APO mailing address is still 887. Our house address is "Huize de Wilde Zee", 35 Raaphorstlaan, Wassenaar. Our telephone is The Hague 2415; this is a military number consisting of only four digits as distinguished from civilian numbers which contain six digits. It is possible to call the Hague by civilian line and be switched over to military number 2415.

I was unable to see [ ] in person, but have written him your message, and will try to see him on my next trip to Eindhoven. (b)(1) 5 (b)(3)

We are now working on a mission for [ ] (see inclosed card on him), which looks rather promising. Expect to forward suggested plan at end of week.
