ACTIVISTS LINKED TO ARMY CHIEF CEDRAS ARE PLANNING A GENERAL STRIKE THIS WEEK AND WILL USE FREE LIQUOR AND ENTERTAINMENT IN THE HOPE OF DRAWING SOME 20,000 TO 30,000 PEOPLE TO AN ANTI-UN DEMONSTRATION. [REDACTED]

COMMENT: THE RIGHTISTS' PLANS FOR A MAJOR DEMONSTRATION PROBABLY ARE UNREALISTIC, BUT THEY MAY BE ABLE TO SHUT DOWN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION TEMPORARILY IN MUCH OF THE CAPITAL. THUGS WORKING FOR THE MILITARY, THE POLICE, AND THE FAR RIGHT PROBABLY WILL CONTINUE TO MOUNT SMALL-SCALE INCIDENTS TO COW THE MALVAL GOVERNMENT AND GENERATE A CLIMATE OF UNCERTAINTY. AS THE DATE FOR ARISTIDE'S RETURN APPROACHES, HIS OPPONENTS MAY TRY A SPECTACULAR ACT OF VIOLENCE, SUCH AS THE ASSASSINATION OF A CABINET MEMBER OR SACKING OF

GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS. ANTI-ARISTIDE ELEMENTS ARE NOT LIKELY TO TARGET THE UN FORCE FOR NOW, BUT RIGHTIST AGITATION COULD STIR NATIONALISTIC RESENTMENT AND INCREASE THE DANGER TO UN PERSONNEL.
