EASTERN EUROPE: Winter Grain Prospects

Eastern Europe's winter grain production, which normally accounts for about one-half of total grain output, is likely to approach the estimated 1976-80 average of 47 million tons in 1981. Above-average production is expected in most countries, but bad weather hindered crop growth in Romania and caused plantings to drop by 12 to 18 percent in Poland and Yugoslavia. [REDACTED]
