1. SOUTH AFRICA: ANOTHER PROTEST

//PRETORIA FACES A MAJOR SHOWDOWN; NONWHITE ACTIVISTS HAVE SAID THEY WILL PROCEED ON WEDNESDAY WITH AN ILLEGAL PROTEST.//

//MORE THAN 20 SENIOR MEMBERS OF THE MULTIRACIAL UNITED DEMOCRATIC FRONT HAVE BEEN ARRESTED FOLLOWING A CALL BY REVEREND ALLAN BOESAK, A COLORED SPOKESMAN FOR THE FRONT, FOR NONWHITES TO PRESS THE GOVERNMENT TO RELEASE JAILED AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS LEADER NELSON MANDELA. BOESAK, WHO HAS GONE INTO HIDING, HAS SAID HE WILL LEAD A MASS MARCH ON POLLSMOOR PRISON NEAR CAPE TOWN, WHERE MANDELA IS BEING HELD. PRETORIA HAS WARNED THAT IT WOULD TAKE STRONG ACTION TO PREVENT THE MARCH.//

//MEANWHILE, CONTINUED UNREST OVER THE PAST WEEK HAS LED IN SOME AREAS TO EVENING CURFEWS, HOUSE-TO-HOUSE SEARCHES, AND LIMITS ON THE POSSESSION OF GASOLINE, OFTEN USED IN HOMEMADE BOMBS. POLICE ARE FORCING YOUTHS TO RETURN TO SCHOOL IN AN EFFORT TO END WIDESPREAD SCHOOL BOYCOTTS. PRETORIA HAS BANNED RALLIES IN TRANSVAAL PROVINCE EXPECTED TO MARK THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE OUTBREAK OF VIOLENCE LAST SEPTEMBER.//



//THE FRONT, WHICH REPRESENTS OVER 600 ORGANIZATIONS, MAY TRY TO CARRY OUT THE MARCH AND ADDITIONAL ACTS OF CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE IN OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY DESPITE THE CRACKDOWN ON ITS LEADERS. PRETORIA UNDOUBTEDLY WILL ARREST BOESAK IF HE ATTEMPTS TO LEAD THE MARCH AND WILL DEAL FIRMLY WITH ANY PROTESTERS WHO DEFY THE GOVERNMENT'S WARNINGS.
