



Chile:

1.5C [REDACTED] The Chilean government's announcement that it will revoke the decree creating the notorious secret police, the National Intelligence Directorate, should help improve its human rights image. President Pinochet had been under fire from civilian and military officials for months to curb DINA's absolute powers.

[REDACTED] Some of DINA's police powers presumably will be assumed by the Carabineros and, [REDACTED] a National Information Center will be formed to gather intelligence "to safeguard national security." Some armed forces intelligence units have also been responsible for the abuses that have occurred in Chile; it is not yet clear whether they are affected by the shakeup. [REDACTED]
