

**Government Fears  
May Day Terrorism  
By Chilean Leftists**

Extreme leftist fanatics in Chile may try to greet May Day with spectacular terrorist action. The government is worried about the possibility of an attack and is taking precautions.

Leaflets signed by the Movement of the Revolutionary Left appeared in Santiago last weekend. The leaflets call for an uprising against the military government on May 1. A small faction of Movement militants, who are determined to take up arms against the junta, reportedly have revived the People's Organized Vanguard—a violence-oriented group that operated between 1965 and 1971.

The government has banned the usual May Day workers' parades and has extended the curfew in Santiago. The government's stringent security measures have severely impeded leftist efforts to undertake opposition activity, but the militant fanatics probably are armed and capable of carrying out hit-and-run attacks.

Junta President Pinochet is scheduled to meet today with representatives of the workers. He is expected to announce wage increases to restore at least some of the purchasing power eroded by inflation since the last pay raises in January. [REDACTED]
