

1. MEMBERS OF [REDACTED] GUILD LEADERS (GUILD TEAM) ARE PUZZLED OVER THE BEHAVIOR OF THE MILITARY DURING THE PAST WEEK. AFTER FIRST RECEIVING INDICATIONS FROM THEIR MILITARY CONTACTS THAT THEY WERE VERY CLOSE TO MOVING AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT, TEAM MEMBERS WERE NOTIFIED SEPARATELY

BY ADMIRAL PATRICIO CARVAJAL, COMMANDER IN CHIEF OF THE NATIONAL DEFENSE STAFF, AND GENERAL GUSTAVO LEIGH, AIR FORCE COMMANDER IN CHIEF, ON 29 AUGUST THAT SUCH AN ACTION MIGHT BE DELAYED FOR SOME TIME. HOWEVER, BOTH CARVAJAL AND LEIGH URGED THE TEAM TO CONTINUE THEIR STRIKES AND OTHER PRESSURES AGAINST THE ADMINISTRATION OF PRESIDENT SALVADOR ALLENDE. CARVAJAL AND LEIGH ALSO SAID THAT COORDINATION AMONG THE MILITARY SERVICES REGARDING POSSIBLE ACTIONS AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT IS GOOD, THAT THEIR PLANS ARE CONTINUING, AND THAT THE GUILD LEADERS SHOULD BE PATIENT AND HAVE CONFIDENCE IN THE MILITARY. THE GUILD TEAM WAS UNSUCCESSFUL IN ITS ATTEMPTS TO CONSULT WITH ITS HIGH-LEVEL ARMY CONTACTS DURING THE PAST WEEK. THEY BELIEVE THAT THE GENERALS' MEETING ON 28-29 AUGUST MUST HAVE INCLUDED SOME ADMONITION TO SUSPEND CONTACTS WITH THE TEAM FOR THE PRESENT.
