1. ACCORDING TO [REDACTED]
 [REDACTED], [REDACTED] NOVEMBER JUNTA PRESIDENT AUGUSTO PINOCHET
 MET WITH [REDACTED] TO DISCUSS CHILE'S INTERNATIONAL
 IMAGE AND THE PERU SITUATION. PINOCHET SAID THAT HE WAS VERY
 DISAPPOINTED AT THE LOPSIDED VOTE (68 TO 5 WITH 33 ABSTENTIONS)
 IN THE UNITED NATIONS (UN) CONDEMNING CHILE ON MATTERS OF HUMAN
 RIGHTS. HE SAID HE WAS PARTICULARLY CONCERNED THAT THE UNITED
 STATES AND SPAIN ABSTAINED INSTEAD OF VOTING AGAINST THE RE-
 SOLUTION.

2. [REDACTED] SUGGESTED THAT PINOCHET SHOULD NOT
 CONSIDER ABSTENTIONS AS INDICATIONS OF POSITIONS AGAINST CHILE.
 IN REALITY, THEY COULD BE CONSIDERED POSITIVE WHEN VIEWED IN
 OVERALL TERMS. [REDACTED] SAID THAT IN ADDITION TO THE AB-
 STENTIONS, THE COUNTRIES VOTING WITH CHILE WERE OF PARTICULAR
 IMPORTANCE, NAMELY ARGENTINA, BRAZIL, EGYPT, SAUDI ARABIA,
 ISRAEL AND ZAMBIA. PINOCHET RESPONDED THAT, ANALYZING THE
 VOTE IN THAT MANNER, PERHAPS HE SHOULD MODIFY HIS INITIAL PESSI-
