1. THE GOVERNMENT OF CHILE (GOC) PLANS TO US THE SCHEDULED VISIT OF U.S. AMBASSADOR EDWARD M E Z V I N S K Y FOR AN ALL OUT EFFORT TO PERSUADE THE U.S. GOVERNMENT TO SUPPORT THE FOLLOWING GOC GOALS:

A. DISSOLUTION OF THE AD HOC WORKING GROUP ON CHILE OF THE UNITED NATIONS HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION (UNHRC).

B. ABANDONMENT OF PLANS FOR THE CREATION OF A SPECIAL FUND FOR THE CHILEAN SITUATION.

C. AN END TO UNHRC INDIVIDUAL REPORTS ON CHILE.

IN RETURN FOR A U.S. COMMITMENT TO SUPPORT CHILE ON THESE

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INITIATIVES, THE GOC IS PREPARED TO AGREE TO A VISIT OF A UNHRC WORKING GROUP DELEGATION, WITHOUT CHAIRMAN ALI A L L A N A, UNDER CONDITIONS PREVIOUSLY ENUMERATED BY CHILEAN AMBASSADOR SERGIO D I E Z.

2. GOC LEADERS WONDER IF AMBASSADOR MEZVINSKY WILL BE PREPARED TO UNDERTAKE SUBSTANTIVE MEGOTIATIONS ON THE ABOVE MATTERS AND WHETHER HE WILL BE EMPOWERED TO MAKE FIRM COMMITMENTS ON THEM. GOC LEADERS FEEL THAT IF AMBASSADOR MEZVINSKY IS UNABLE TO MAKE A SOLID COMMITMENT ON THE ABOVE CHILEAN POSITIONS, THE GOC SHOULD REITERATE ITS PREVIOUSLY STATED TOTAL OPPOSITION TO ANY FURTHER COOPERATION WITH THE UNHRC WORKING GROUP.
