

Purpose: To inform the NSC, State Department, and Justice of:

- Our notification to Congress of recent Agency reporting implicating Guatemalan Colonel Alpírez [REDACTED] in the 1992 killing of insurgent leader Bamaca.

PASSAGE OF INFORMATION TO JENNIFER HARBURY AND MINUGUA

- (For ADCI Background: AC/LA and C/LA met with representatives of the NSC, State, Justice, and the Office of the Vice President on 6 February, and reviewed the 3 February Congressional briefings. At the 6 February meeting, a decision was made to provide to Bamaca's wife, Jennifer Harbury, the demarche delivered on 6 February to the Government of Guatemala. State was to have delivered that statement to Harbury evening of 8 February and we expect confirmation today that this took place.
