INTELLIGENCE: ASSET GAVE [REDACTED] INFORMATION ON DIANA ORTIZ HUMAN RIGHTS CASE. HE CLAIMED THAT TWO DAYS BEFORE SISTER ORTIZ LEFT HER POST IN HUEHUETENANGO, TWO GUERRILLAS WERE CAPTURED NEAR SAN MIGUEL ACATAN (15-42N,91-37W). WHEN THESE GUERRILLAS WERE CAPTURED THEY ONLY HAD ONE CARBINE AND ONE ROUND OF AMMUNITION BETWEEN THEM. THEY WERE TAKEN TO THE MILITARY ZONE IN HUEHUETENANGO WHERE THEY WERE INTERROGATED. THEY TOLD THE MILITARY AUTHORITIES THAT THEY HAD NOT EATEN IN THREE DAYS AND THAT THEY WERE WAITING FOR SISTER ORTIZ TO BRING THEM FOOD AND AMMUNITION. NO OTHER INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE ON THIS CASE.
