affirmed that he has four letters which prove beyond a doubt that U.S. citizen Jennifer Harbury is a fraud. [REDACTED] plans to present the papers in court, but refused to give details on what these testimonials may contain.

[REDACTED] has witnesses who will testify that Efrain Bamaca Velasquez committed suicide when he realized he was going to be apprehended by the Guatemalan Army.

[REDACTED] sent telegrams to every Mayor's office in Guatemala (431 "alcaldias") asking for information anyone may have on the case, and also on the existence of clandestine prisons. [REDACTED] there were no results thus far.

Bamaca's father, [REDACTED] saw his son shortly before he disappeared and [REDACTED] he made no mention of being married to a U.S. citizen or having spent time in the U.S. However, during a public hearing on 7 November, the father changed his story, and said he had not seen his son since he left home at 18 years of age.
