THE ARMY PATROL SUBSEQUENTLY TURNED BAHACA OVER TO THE G-2 ([REDACTED]) IN SAN MARCOS DEPARTMENT. BAHACA WAS HELD IN SAN MARCOS AND IN SANTA ANA BERLIN, QUETZALTENANGO DEPARTMENT, [REDACTED]

2. THE [REDACTED] OFFICER STATED BAHACA WAS NOT TORTURED. HE ADDED THAT THE CAPTURE OF BAHACA WAS SIGNIFICANT, [REDACTED]
