SAID THERE IS A RUMOR CIRCULATING [REDACTED] THAT IT IS FUTILE FOR THE U.S. CITIZEN SPOUSE OF FORMER REVOLUTIONARY ORGANIZATION OF PEOPLE IN ARMS (ORPA) COMMANDER EFRAIN ((BAMACA)) VELASQUEZ, ALIAS "COMANDANTE EVERARDO," TO BE SEARCHING FOR BAMACA'S REMAINS AT THE CABANAS DETACHMENT, SAN MARCOS DEPARTMENT. THE RUMOR HAS IT THAT THE U.S. CITIZEN WILL NOT FIND BAMACA'S BODY BECAUSE AFTER HE WAS KILLED, HIS BODY WAS BURNED. (GUATEMALA CITY FIELD COMMENT: THIS INFORMATION SHOULD BE CHARACTERIZED AS RUMOR. THERE IS NO OTHER INFORMATION TO CORROBORATE THAT BAMACA'S BODY WAS BURNED.)
