1. The samples were examined and tested with the following results:

Moisture	18.9 per cent
Protein (calculated to 14% moisture base)	12.8 " "
Fat acidity	15
Test weight per bushel	61.8 pounds
Proportion of damaged kernels	Negligible
Odor	Normal

The sample contained a very small amount of bindweed seed (*Convolvulus Arvensis*) which was not considered particularly objectionable, as it is fairly easy to remove by proper cleaning procedures.

2. The examiner has reported the following conclusions:

- a. The fat acidity is within the range characteristic of freshly-harvested, sound wheat produced in the USA.
- b. The wheat is similar in appearance to USA, hard, red, winter wheat.
- c. Although the sample size was insufficient to permit milling and baking tests, it is believed that the sample is of a type that would be satisfactory for the production of bread flour.
