OPERATION MICKEY

MICKEY operation was successfully completed on the night of the 24th of February 1945. The agent, an Italian girl, was dropped some 35 kms south of Pforzheim with the specific mission of identifying any units of the 19th Army, in the region of Kaiserslautern-Hombourg-Saarbrücken. Her cover story was that she was in search of her father who had disappeared while on a business trip and from whom she had had no word. She was looking for him at the home of various business acquaintances who were in the same line of business as he was. Her search was to carry her along the route outlined by G-2, 7th Army. Her explanation of being in the region of the pinpoint was that she had hitched a ride on a truck going North from Lake Konstanz and had been dropped off near one of her father's business friends. The agent will also attempt to contact the agent of operation MIMI who has not been heard from thus far. She has not yet returned through the lines.
