OPERATION "PERNOD"

PERSONNEL: Agent "JOE", [REDACTED] (S)(1)

- MISSION:
1. To infiltrate through lines into BITCHE to the home of his uncle, [REDACTED] (S)(1)
(S)(3)C
 2. To organize sub-agents to cover region PIRMASENS-
KAISERSLAUTERN-HOMBURG-ZWEIBRUCKEN.
 3. To send these couriers back to Allied lines beginning
15 March with the desired intelligence.
 4. Agent to be over-run by possible Allied advance or come
back through our lines depending on length of time
necessary to secure the intelligence.

TIME &
PASSAGE

OF OPERATION: At 1100 hours 12 March 1945, Lt. Patterson, Agent "JOE"
and the undersigned arrived at the 1st Bn., 399th
Infantry Regiment, 100th Infantry Division at SIERSTHAL
7249. The Battalion S-2 accompanied us to "K" Company
CP at 746505. From there we proceeded to a point on
the front line which was not under enemy observation and
from there Agent JOE took off. He was observed for
approximately 500 yards into "no-mans" land whereat he
entered the woods at 750505.
