

OPERATION "NOAH"

GENERAL OBJECTIVE : Military and intelligence in the region of STUTTGART.

(S)(3), (S)(1)<sub>2</sub>

PHASE A : Agents [REDACTED] ( see questionnaires Nos. II and I2 ) infiltrate into enemy territory North of Mulhouse towards the village of LITTERBACH. They are to join the refugees convoy at PULVERSHEIM. A guide is provided, who will take them to three safe houses at PULVERSHEIM. From there they will travel by rail towards STUTTGART where a series of safe houses has been provided for them. ( See appendix No. ) There they will prepare the arrival of:

PHASE B

AGENTS : [REDACTED]

RADIO OPERATOR : [REDACTED]

COMMUNICATIONS : T.R.I. set through SUNNY RIDGE or 7th Army which will be decided by Henry Hyde actually in London.

MODE OF INFILTRATION : Parachute drop in the vicinity of one of the safe houses. Pinpoint still pending on approval of London. Phase A agents will be informed which safe house has been selected through BBC prearranged messages.

PACKAGE : Two suitcases - One T.R.I. suitcase.

Documents for Phase A agents have been made out at Mulhouse. Documents for Phase B agents (cover "french industrial worker") have been taken care of by Henry Hyde in London.
