In July of 1936 left for Spain to serve in Republican army, where drove supplies between Madrid and Barcelona. End of 1938 returned to France, stayed in Toulouse, then Toulon, until declaration of war, when he joined the 5th Depot d'Equipages at Toulon as Second Maitre until June of 1940 when he was demobilized at armistice.

Then went to parents at St. Etienne; stayed there until January, 1941; then to Paris to join the Maquis until June, 1943. In June, 1943, was captured by Germans on train at Chalon/s/Saone; they took him to Cherche-Midi Prison for eight months, on grounds of attacking a German officer. 5-3-44 was taken to Niemburg(between Bremen and Hannover), where he worked as a baker.

Escaped to Uetzen (province of Hannover), travelling on fake Bescheinigung zur Benutzung der Eisenbahn given him by girl who worked in Arbeitsamt. This and statement by employer on letterhead was all he needed. Escaped from Uetzen 17-12-45 via Switzerland.

Is not married.

Special knowledge: [redacted] naval supplies; slight Morse. Was once a boxer. A little boastful, but seems alert and straightforward. Knows Berlin, Hamburg, Bremen, Hannover, and Uetzen; Knows army and naval artillery. Has two brothers and sisters. Tough and selfreliant. Subsisted by operating black market. Escaped in load of hay.

B. Character of Mission

Will be dropped in Niemburg area, where will orient self and then proceed south to Munich region where will remain on permanent mission. Will be dropped alone; radio operator will perhaps be sent in later. Time in northern Germany for orientation about three weeks.

Agent is coming to London for briefing, etc.

Operation will be mounted for moon-period beginning 8-9 February.
