OPERATION LAHO I

LAHO with Operation SAMSON will pass the lines West of Haguenau 16/2/45 and proceed on foot to Karlsruhe.

[REDACTED] Deutsche Volkszugehörige Elsasserin, was born in Mulhausen. She has a Kennkarte issued at Strasbourg 24/10/42. She was a Büro-Angestellte at the Bessero Bakery in Strasbourg-Robertsau, until the Spring of 1944 when she joined the Schuhfabrik Gebr. HAAS in Dettweiler near Zabern. When the latter was captured she was arrested by the FFI on 24/11/44, and put in the prison camp. As she was familiar with the region and was a capable secretary, she was given a certificate of liberte provisoire by the FFI on 4/1/45, on condition that she do stenographic work and generally help out at the camp, reporting every other day to the FFI.

She never had a Arbeitsbuch because of lung trouble as witnessed by a discharge from the Lungenheilstaette fur Angestellte of the Reichsversicherungsanstalt in Strasbourg dated 2/3/44.

June 1944 she had met [REDACTED] of the 2nd Co., 936th Regt., 245th Inf. Div. and has a letter from him dated 10/11/44 asking her to get to Heidelberg where a letter from him will be awaiting her at the general delivery.
