

OPERATION PENICILLIN (MARIA)

28 April 1945

[REDACTED] an Alsatian, crossed the Rhine at Naf-Brisach 2/1/45 and helped care for wounded German soldiers in Freiburg. Before the city fell on 22/4/45 she fled Eastward and on the morning of \_\_\_\_\_ is at 295925 Sheet Y-5 6 km NE of Tussen. (B)(1)

She is in search of her lover, [REDACTED] whom she had met in 1944 near Strassburg. She thinks he may be in Innsbruck so is cutting South to the Lermees Pfaffenheim-Innsbruck highway.

As she must turn North in Innsbruck, she has a certificate from the Res-Az. Altoetting that she is to conduct a wounded soldier from there to Innsbruck. She is now on her way back, the certificate having been stamped in Innsbruck on 2/5/45 authorizing her to return to Altoetting via Rosenheim.

Her whole route therefore is Kempten-Fuessen-Oberau-Garmich-Mittenwald-Innsbruck-Kufstein-Rosenheim.
