Unit: PW who has been in German Army for 4 years and contracted Malaria in the Caucasus, was arrested on furlough from the hospital in his home on 29 Jan 45 and returned to his

He spent about one year in Hospital at HUENFELD (H4332). When friendly troops approached the FULDA sector, he escaped from hospital and walked through HOME RHOEN Mtns, trying to make his way South. 16 TD Bn arrested him (he is wearing civilian clothes) in KULSHEIM (N2820) to be processed through PW channels. PW claims to have been discharged from Army on 25 Mar 45, but cannot prove his discharge because his papers were taken away by SS troops when he refused to join a straggler outfit and fight again.

Locations in "The National Redoubt": (as of end of Jan 45)

Hitler's house at OBERSALZBERG (Z978064) is little used. HITLER spends most of his time in VON RIBBENTROP's House on Lake FUSCHL (V149271).

Well camouflaged barracks near BERCHTESGADEN at STRUB (Z931022), containing OCS, SS and Mtn Inf and Fortification Staff with 4 highranking Officers (Generals?), and at (Z904102) and (Z908102) astride RR and road in woods.

AA positions, protecting BERCHTESGADEN, at STRUB near Bcks, in rocks of HOHER GOELL Mtn (V0002) and UNTERSBERG Mtn (Z9014-9313).

Meeting place of Reich Government (maybe even its new official Seat) in SCHLOSS KLESSHEIM (Z9326). Meetings take place there instead of HITLER's home at OBERSALZBERG because latter location had become too much publicized.

Newly constructed RR Station for SCHLOSS KLESSHEIM, well camouflaged, at (Z944270).

Reliable personalities to be contacted in BERCHTESGADEN:

Count DEYM, his wife Louise, his mother-in-law Mrs. SEIDENBOECK née GIFT and the latter's brother, Dr. Philipp GIFT, a former lawyer, all living at Haus Wolfseck, SCHOENAU (Z944036). Mrs. SEIDENBOECK and her brother are Jews, but were protected because of connections with Mrs. Emmy GOERING and Mrs. KRUPP-vonBOHLEN-HALBACH.
