

In the attached note JIGGS states:

1. ENGELHARDT in Muenchen, a friend of his, runs one of the biggest sporting goods stores in the city and could provide mountaineering equipment.

2. The "Alpine Ski Guide" and accompanying maps are at JIGGS' house [redacted] (S)(3)
[redacted] of the Schliersee. The maps cover the Eastern Alps.

3. Also near his home, in the Schliersee mountains is a hostel where the maps and guides of the German and Austrian Alpine Society are secreted. These maps, at 1:25000, show huts, paths, glaciers, etc. The business office of the society is in the hostel. JIGGS knows the manager, whom he trusts; he saw him as late as 15 March. The hostel is 30 minutes from Neuhaus.

4. There are various paths and roads from Neuhaus to the Inn valley and Innsbruck which JIGGS knows.

5. He knows, and could contact with profit to any Alpine work Major BAUER, leader of many expeditions in the Himalayas and now head of the Army Mountain School in Fulpmes 9943, Sheet Z6; and Prof. Karl HETZEL, head of the Akademischer Alpenverein in Muenchen.
