1. Major GRAHAM after consultation with Colonel OSBORNE, has stated that since FREIBURG is in French sphere of interest, and since the place is swarming with French agents, evidently responsible for the confusion of reports, we should leave the investigating there to FRANCE.

2. Accordingly [REDACTED] directives should be altered to emphasize the KARLSRUHE, OFFENBURG area, including the side trip to OBERKIRCH. It is possible that the Oberkommando der Rhein may be in the KARLSRUHE area as well as in the FREIBURG region. No one really seems to know. The second priority questions indicated in paragraph 3 of my letter of Jan 17th should be used for the specific informations desired.

3. New identifications in the region are the present data of G-2. [REDACTED] should attempt to copy and reproduce for us divisional and regimental insignia and numbers which she sees. And as always the questions of concentration points and numbers of tanks, and direction of movement are standard.
