1. Lt. Willard and [REDACTED] returned from Mulhouse mission on the 22nd inst. (see report attached).

2. Lt. Hoguet took agents, Max and Fritz, to concentration camp at Rothau and had them interned. They will remain there for 24 hours and then be returned to Lyon after interrogation.

3. Capt. Green, 7th Army CIC, formerly 3rd Division, indicated two possible agents, one of whom is particularly familiar with the Westwall defenses. [REDACTED] was sent to 7th Army CIC to check on them. One of the men [REDACTED] may be a potential agent. The other man, [REDACTED] will be seen on the 24th inst. for further interrogation. [REDACTED]
