c. Suzanne CAMPAUX, born 14 April 1904 at Toul (Meurthe et Moselle), France, married ~~Mary~~ SLONIM, who now resides in the United States, in 1918. They had one daughter named Helene SLONIM. The SLONIMS were divorced in 1926 and Suzanne CAMPAUX became the mistress of Vassili SOUKHOMLINE. In 1937 she married Hjalmar BISHAM-HOLMES with whom she resides at 2 rue Auguste Bartholdi, Paris 15e, the address mentioned by FUCHS.

d. Helene ^{for} SLONIM, Suzanne CAMPAUX's daughter, was born in 1920 and in 1940 she married Jean Maurice ^{MRS} PRICE. They had one child, Alain PRICE, born 31 July 1941. They were divorced in 1945 ^{MRS & M} and on 10 September 1946 Helene SLONIM married Nicolas MALINOWSKI. Her permanent address was given as 146 Boulevard Montparnasse, Paris 14e, although she is believed to be in England at the present time.
