THE FINAL DISPOSITION OF SREBRENICA, ZEPA, AND GORAZDE HAS BEEN A MAJOR OBSTACLE TO A NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT. [REDACTED]

TIMING OF ASSAULT ON SREBRENICA

-- THE GOVERNMENT ATTACK ON A SERB VILLAGE NEAR SREBRENICA ON 26 JUNE MAY HAVE CAUSED THE SERBS TO ORDER THE OFFENSIVE AGAINST THE ENCLAVE AFTER ALL, ALTHOUGH IT IS UNCLEAR WHETHER THEY INITIALLY INTENDED TO CAPTURE THE ENTIRE SAFE AREA.

[REDACTED] BOSNIAN ARMY SPECIAL OPERATIONS UNITS HAVE BEEN QUITE SUCCESSFUL AGAINST TARGETS BEHIND BSA LINES AND [REDACTED] THE ATTACK ON THE SERB VILLAGE NEAR SREBRENICA HAD SO ANGERED THE BSA GENERAL STAFF IT HAD VOWED TO TAKE SREBRENICA WHENEVER IT WANTED AND TO PUSH ASIDE UN UNITS IF GOVERNMENT COMMANDO ATTACKS CONTINUED. [REDACTED]

THE OTHER ENCLAVES

THE SERBS BEGAN SHELLING ZEPA THE SAME DAY THEY BEGAN THE ATTACK ON SREBRENICA. THE FRONTLINE BETWEEN THE TWO ENCLAVES WAS ONLY 5 KM APART, CIVILIANS AND MILITARY PERSONNEL OFTEN INFILTRATED BETWEEN THE TWO, AND ZEPA HAD BEEN USED AS A BASE FOR RAIDS ON SERB-HELD TERRITORY. [REDACTED] ELIMINATION OF THE GORAZDE ENCLAVE REPORTEDLY IS PART OF THE PLAN TO "CLEANSE" EASTERN BOSNIA OF ITS MUSLIM POPULATION, BUT THE SERBS PROBABLY WILL CHOOSE TO CONSOLIDATE THEIR GAINS AROUND SREBRENICA BEFORE STARTING ANOTHER OFFENSIVE.

-- MOREOVER, GORAZDE COVERS A LARGER AREA THAN THE OTHER EASTERN ENCLAVES AND IS OCCUPIED BY MORE GOVERNMENT TROOPS. THE SERBS WOULD NEED TO REINFORCE THE REGION BEFORE CARRYING OUT AN OPERATION THERE. [REDACTED]

IN THE BIHAC ENCLAVE, OTHER PARTIES ARE INVOLVED IN THE CONFLICT, INCLUDING BOSNIAN CROATS, CROATIANS, KRAJINA SERBS, AND FIKRET ABDIC'S REBEL MUSLIMS. RATHER THAN CAPTURING THE ENTIRE ENCLAVE, THE BOSNIAN SERBS PROBABLY WOULD BE MORE ABLE TO NEUTRALIZE GOVERNMENT TROOPS AND TO INSTALL ABDIC AS THEIR PUPPET. BOSNIAN ARMY FORCES THERE ARE SOME OF THE MOST CAPABLE GOVERNMENT TROOPS, AND AN ATTEMPT TO ELIMINATE THE ENCLAVE WOULD REQUIRE A STRONGER FORCE THAN APPEARS TO BE CURRENTLY AVAILABLE TO THE BSA. OPTIONS AVAILABLE TO IT IN THE NEAR TERM INCLUDE:
